

Weekly Update

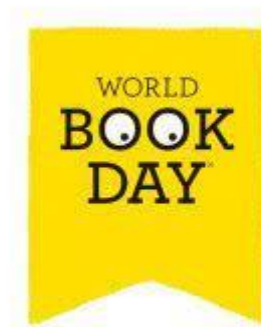


Friday 1st March
