

Weekly Update

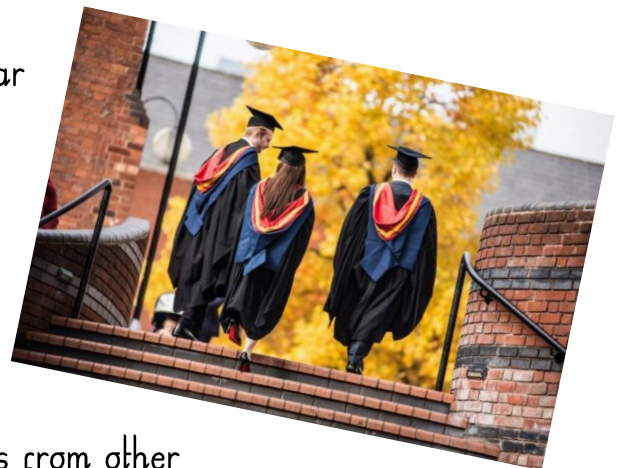


Friday 20th June
