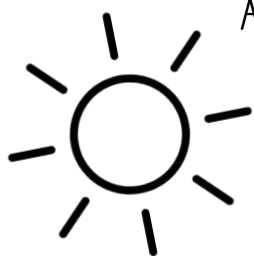
## TRANSITION
